Second Semester Exam Waiver Policy

This policy is designed to reward consistent academic effort, attendance, and punctuality throughout the semester. Please ensure you meet all requirements to take advantage of this opportunity. For the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year, students who meet the following criteria will be eligible for an exam waiver. The waiver applies only to students enrolled in face-to-face classes.

Requirements for Face-to-Face Students

To qualify for an exam waiver, students must maintain the following standards in **ALL classes**, including those taken at CTC:

1. Academic Performance:

• Achieve a grade of **B** (83%) or better in the class(es) they wish to be exempt from up until the day of the exam.

2. Attendance Rate:

- Maintain an overall attendance rate of 95% or greater (fewer than 5 full day absences) up until the Friday prior to exams as identified by Power School attendance program.
- All absences (excused/unexcused/medical), except school-related absences, will count toward this requirement.

3. Overall Attendance Policy:

 Not exceed 9 total absences in any class, including excused, unexcused, and medical absences.

4. Tardiness:

• Have **2** or fewer tardies in each class that they otherwise qualify to waive up until the Friday before exams.

Additional Reminders:

- Due to the fact that Fruitport High School contracts with third party vendors to provide virtual learning, students who are fully virtual or taking a virtual course in conjunction with their in-person schedule do not qualify for exam waivers in those virtual courses. Virtual students are not eligible for the exam waiver for their online/virtual classes.
- Students who receive in-school suspension (ISS) or out-of-school suspension (OSS) at any point during the semester will not qualify for the exam waiver.
- The tracking of absences and tardies for this policy will begin on January 21, 2025.
