- ❖ If you submitted an address change during registration on your parent portal, you must turn in an updated proof of residency to the high school office before the address will be updated.
- Parents are reminded that if a student needs to leave early for an appointment, please send a note in the morning with the student to bring to student services for an early dismissal pass. This allows the student to leave class and meet their ride outside of the building. With this process, no one has to come into the building to check out the student. This also helps eliminate classroom disruptions.

- Fruitport Middle School is sponsoring a Show Up & Glow Up 5k run/walk event on Saturday, October 4 at 5:00 p.m.. This is a community family friendly event held at the Fruitport Varsity football field. - Students are encouraged to stop by the cafeteria each morning from 7:15-7:30 a.m. to grab free breakfast. Breakfast is free again this year to all students.
- The Homecoming dance will be held on **Saturday, September 27 from 7:00 10:00 p.m.** in the High School cafeteria. All students grades 9 12 are invited to attend. The dance is semi-formal attire. Tickets for the dance will go on sale on Wednesday, September 17 - Friday, September 19, 2025 during lunches only. The cost of tickets will be \$15/person. After these dates, any late tickets purchased will cost \$25.00 each. Please plan ahead to avoid the late fee. Cash or Check only is accepted.

As a reminder, any student that has fees/items owed to the high school will need to have these paid before they are allowed to attend the dance. This includes all library, lunch and athletic fees. **No tickets will be sold at the door.** 

- A Parking Permits. Please fill out the form on the bottom of the high school homepage and submit it. Once the form has been submitted you may pay for and pick up your permit in student services. The cost is \$20 and permits must be displayed by 9/12. Those cars without a permit may be ticketed or towed.

- ❖ A couple of reminders are that we do still need medical notes turned in or faxed to the office for those absences to be coded as medical absences. The best and quickest way for your student to obtain an early dismissal pass is for him or her to drop off a parent note in Student Services and we will write them the pass to be dismissed.
